I. Monetary Donations - our most urgent need! How funds are used:

- \$50 - Complete Health Package = exam, vaccines, flea/worm treatment, county license
- \$125 - Overpopulation Prevention = spay/neuter surgery and vaccines
- \$250 - Diagnostics = bloodwork or x-rays to help diagnose and treat emergency cases
- \$500 - Emergency Care = extensive care or surgery for a very sick pet

- Other professional services: photography, printing/graphics, publicity, and more

III. Donate Medical or Pet Care Supplies (used or out-dated supplies are fine)

- Open or expired medications (human or animal) in original prescription packaging
- Flea products for all sizes of cats & dogs (Advantage, Frontline, etc)
- Cat and dog leashes, collars & harnesses (all sizes)
- Pet carriers (any type, including large wire or plastic crates for our clinics)
- Pet food (open bags of food are fine, especially prescription diets)
- Blankets, dog sweaters, fleece & rain coats
- Dog safety vests & backpacks
- Zip-lock style plastic bags (quart & gallon size) for repackaging food
- Vaccines (FVRCP, FELV, DHPPV, RV)
- Cat bags and dog muzzles
