Possible fundraising projects:

Car wash: a great fundraiser for a summer project

Dog wash: contact local dog wash businesses to donate a day for you and friends to volunteer to wash dogs for PAW Team donations

Doggy Treats Bake Sale: doggy biscuits and treats are a unique baked item! Contact us for some healthy and safe recipes for baking pet treats. Set up your own table to sell baked goods, or package the pet treats and we'll sell them at PAW Team booths.

Recycling: form a team to collect returnable cans and bottles and turn them in for cash to donate to PAW Team. Help our environment and PAW Team at the same time!

PAW Team Pet Presents: Decorate or create your own dog collars, leashes, blankets, toys, water bowls or other pet-related items to be sold at PAW Team event booths.

Independent volunteer or classroom/group activities:

- **Deliver pet food** and litter to seniors and those unable to drive/travel
- **Make posters** on pet health care or nutrition to hang on our clinic walls, or flyers with information to hand out to our clients for their pets
- **Create a "photo wall"** of people and their pets to be posted in the window at our clinic
